2) Cody collected 2 rocks from his garden. The first was 328 grams and the second was 563 grams. To the nearest ten, what is the combined weight (in grams) of both rocks?	ten $330 + 560$ 890	hundred $328 + 563$ $891 = 890$	2. <u>890</u>
3) Roger was playing his favorite video game. In the first round he scored 239 points and in round two he scored 157 points. To the nearest hundred, how many points did he score total?	ten $200 + 200$ 400	hundred $239 + 157$ $396 = 400$	3. <u>400</u>
4) Maria was looking through old photo albums. The first had 167 pics and the second had 114. To the nearest ten, how many pictures were there total?	ten $170 + 110$ 280	hundred $167 + 114$ $281 = 280$	4. <u>280</u>
5) In a month, a video store rented out 905 action movies and 542 other types of movies. To the nearest hundred, what is the sum of the movies they rented in a month?	ten $900 + 500$ 1400	hundred $905 + 542$ $1447 = 1400$	5. <u>1,400</u>
6) John was reading through his favorite book series. The first book he read had 599 pages and the next book had 292 pages. To the nearest ten, how many pages were in both books?	ten $600 + 290$ 890	hundred $599 + 292$ $891 = 890$	6. <u>890</u>
7) Two friends were counting the amount of candy they scored for Halloween. James received 428 pieces and Dan received 610 pieces. To the nearest ten, what is the combined amount they both received?	ten $610 + 430$ 1040	hundred $610 + 428$ $1038 = 1040$	7. <u>1,040</u>
8) In one year a photographer took 628 pictures of animals and 181 pictures of people. To the nearest ten, how many pictures did he take total?	ten $180 + 630$ 810	hundred $181 + 628$ $809 = 810$	8. <u>810</u>
9) While working on his car, Tom spent 154 dollars on a new paint job and 910 dollars on the transmission. To the nearest ten, how much money did he spend total?	ten $150 + 910$ 1060	hundred $154 + 910$ $1064 = 1060$	9. <u>1,060</u>
10) A grocery store ordered 159 bottles of regular soda and 347 bottles of diet soda. To the nearest ten, what is the total number of bottles the store ordered?	ten $160 + 350$ 510	hundred $159 + 347$ $506 = 510$	10. <u>510</u>
