- 2) Maria bought 5 sodas at the state fair. If each soda cost \$1.70 and she paid with a twenty dollar bill, how much change should she get back?
- 3) Haley bought 2 books at the school book fair. If each book cost \$4.35 and she paid with a twenty dollar bill, how much change should she get back?
- 4) Adam bought 4 footballs at the sports supply store. If each football cost \$0.05 and he paid with a twenty dollar bill, how much change should he get back?
- 5) Paul bought 2 posters at the game store. If each poster cost \$3.70 and he paid with a twenty dollar bill, how much change should he get back?
- 6) Oliver bought 3 boxes of candy at the theater. If each box of candy cost \$4.15 and he paid with a twenty dollar bill, how much change should he get back?
- 7) Tom bought 5 action figures at the toy store. If each action figure cost \$1.25 and he paid with a twenty dollar bill, how much change should he get back?
- 8) Tiffany bought 4 cases at the phone store. If each case cost \$4.85 and she paid with a twenty dollar bill, how much change should she get back?
- 9) Paige bought 3 soft back books at the book store. If each soft back book cost \$2.50 and she paid with a twenty dollar bill, how much change should she get back?
- 10) Emily bought 2 gift bags at the Santa Store. If each gift bag cost \$2.60 and she paid with a twenty dollar bill, how much change should she get back?

- 1) Carol bought 2 erasers at the school shop. If each eraser cost \$0.95 and she paid with a twenty dollar bill, how much change should she get back?
 $0.95 \times 2 = 1.90$
- 2) Maria bought 5 sodas at the state fair. If each soda cost \$1.70 and she paid with a twenty dollar bill, how much change should she get back?
 $1.70 \times 5 = 8.50$
- 3) Haley bought 2 books at the school book fair. If each book cost \$4.35 and she paid with a twenty dollar bill, how much change should she get back?
 $4.35 \times 2 = 8.70$
- 4) Adam bought 4 footballs at the sports supply store. If each football cost \$0.05 and he paid with a twenty dollar bill, how much change should he get back?
 $0.05 \times 4 = 0.20$
- 5) Paul bought 2 posters at the game store. If each poster cost \$3.70 and he paid with a twenty dollar bill, how much change should he get back?
 $3.70 \times 2 = 7.40$
- 6) Oliver bought 3 boxes of candy at the theater. If each box of candy cost \$4.15 and he paid with a twenty dollar bill, how much change should he get back?
 $4.15 \times 3 = 12.45$
- 7) Tom bought 5 action figures at the toy store. If each action figure cost \$1.25 and he paid with a twenty dollar bill, how much change should he get back?
 $1.25 \times 5 = 6.25$
- 8) Tiffany bought 4 cases at the phone store. If each case cost \$4.85 and she paid with a twenty dollar bill, how much change should she get back?
 $4.85 \times 4 = 19.40$
- 9) Paige bought 3 soft back books at the book store. If each soft back book cost \$2.50 and she paid with a twenty dollar bill, how much change should she get back?
 $2.50 \times 3 = 7.50$
- 10) Emily bought 2 gift bags at the Santa Store. If each gift bag cost \$2.60 and she paid with a twenty dollar bill, how much change should she get back?
 $2.60 \times 2 = 5.20$
