- 5) A farmer was planting seeds in a garden. He planted 762 radish seeds and 394 turnip seeds. To the nearest hundred, how many seeds did he plant total?
  
- 6) While playing a trivia game, Team A scored 777 points and Team B scored 977 points. To the nearest hundred, how many points were scored total?
  
- 7) A school had 472 red pens and 501 blue pens. To the nearest ten, how many pens did they have total?
  
- 8) At a hotdog eating contest, in the first round 981 hotdogs were eaten and in round two another 810 were eaten. To the nearest ten, how many hotdogs were eaten total?

2) At the dog show there were 457 large dogs and 328 small dogs. To the nearest ten, how many dogs were at the dog show?	ten $460 + 330$ 790	hundred $457 + 328$ $785 = 790$	2. <u>790</u>
3) In one month a furniture store sold 145 plastic chairs and 692 wooden chairs. To the nearest hundred, how many chairs did they sell total?	ten $100 + 700$ 800	hundred $145 + 692$ $837 = 800$	3. <u>800</u>
4) In one day, a mail truck gave out 905 letters and 911 magazines. To the nearest hundred, how many pieces of mail did was delivered total?	ten $900 + 900$ 1800	hundred $905 + 911$ $1816 = 1800$	4. <u>1,800</u>
5) A farmer was planting seeds in a garden. He planted 762 radish seeds and 394 turnip seeds. To the nearest hundred, how many seeds did he plant total?	ten $800 + 400$ 1200	hundred $762 + 394$ $1156 = 1200$	5. <u>1,200</u>
6) While playing a trivia game, Team A scored 777 points and Team B scored 977 points. To the nearest hundred, how many points were scored total?	ten $800 + 1000$ 1800	hundred $777 + 977$ $1754 = 1800$	6. <u>1,800</u>
7) A school had 472 red pens and 501 blue pens. To the nearest ten, how many pens did they have total?	ten $470 + 500$ 970	hundred $472 + 501$ $973 = 970$	7. <u>970</u>
8) At a hotdog eating contest, in the first round 981 hotdogs were eaten and in round two another 810 were eaten. To the nearest ten, how many hotdogs were eaten total?	ten $980 + 810$ 1790	hundred $981 + 810$ $1791 = 1790$	8. <u>1,790</u>
9) A pet store had 511 goldfish and 658 clown fish. To the nearest ten, what is the total number of both types of fish?	ten $510 + 660$ 1170	hundred $511 + 658$ $1169 = 1170$	9. <u>1,170</u>
10) While organizing her files, Robin deleted 453 pictures and 146 songs. To the nearest hundred, what is the total number of files she deleted?	ten $500 + 100$ 600	hundred $453 + 146$ $599 = 600$	10. <u>600</u>
