2) While working on his car, Will spent 529 dollars on a new paint job and 652 dollars on the transmission. To the nearest ten, how much money did he spend total?	<b>ten</b> $530 + 650$ <b>1180</b>	<b>hundred</b> $529 + 652$ $1181 = 1180$	2. <b>1,180</b>
3) At a hotdog eating contest, in the first round 700 hotdogs were eaten and in round two another 923 were eaten. To the nearest hundred, how many hotdogs were eaten total?	<b>ten</b> $700 + 900$ <b>1600</b>	<b>hundred</b> $700 + 923$ $1623 = 1600$	3. <b>1,600</b>
4) In one year a photographer took 135 pictures of animals and 886 pictures of people. To the nearest hundred, how many pictures did he take total?	<b>ten</b> $900 + 100$ <b>1000</b>	<b>hundred</b> $886 + 135$ $1021 = 1000$	4. <b>1,000</b>
5) While organizing her files, Vanessa deleted 357 pictures and 821 songs. To the nearest hundred, what is the total number of files she deleted?	<b>ten</b> $400 + 800$ <b>1200</b>	<b>hundred</b> $357 + 821$ $1178 = 1200$	5. <b>1,200</b>
6) During a 'Super Saturday Sale', a shoe store sold 565 pairs of sneakers and 193 pairs of sandals. To the nearest ten, what is the total number of shoes the store sold?	<b>ten</b> $570 + 190$ <b>760</b>	<b>hundred</b> $565 + 193$ $758 = 760$	6. <b>760</b>
7) In a month, a video store rented out 780 action movies and 415 other types of movies. To the nearest ten, what is the sum of the movies they rented in a month?	<b>ten</b> $780 + 420$ <b>1200</b>	<b>hundred</b> $780 + 415$ $1195 = 1200$	7. <b>1,200</b>
8) A candy company sells 408 boxes of sugar candy and 299 boxes of chocolate candy every day. To the nearest hundred, what is the sum of the boxes of candy they sell?	<b>ten</b> $400 + 300$ <b>700</b>	<b>hundred</b> $408 + 299$ $707 = 700$	8. <b>700</b>
9) For her birthday Paige received 341 dollars from her friends and another 140 dollars from her family. To the nearest ten, how much money would Paige have total?	<b>ten</b> $340 + 140$ <b>480</b>	<b>hundred</b> $341 + 140$ $481 = 480$	9. <b>480</b>
10) At Carol's school there are 870 students in 3rd grade and 404 students in 4th grade. To the nearest hundred, how many students were there in both grades?	<b>ten</b> $900 + 400$ <b>1300</b>	<b>hundred</b> $870 + 404$ $1274 = 1300$	10. <b>1,300</b>
