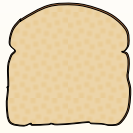




Determine which letter best represents the weight.

A pound is about the weight of a can of vegetables.

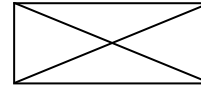
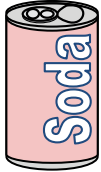
