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Now that we know where they live and what they eat, let's learn about their life cycle and their relationship with us humans. Broadsnouted caimans lay eggs, and the mother guards her nest until the babies, called hatchlings, are born. Humans, on the other hand, have different relationships with these creatures; some people see them as dangerous while others protect them as important parts of the ecosystem. So, while they may seem scary with their wide snouts and sharp teeth, remember they are just trying to survive, just like us, in this big, wide world.
