- 1) Tom ate a snack with 94.36 total calories. If the chips he ate were 48.86 calories, how many calories were in the rest of his snack?
- 2) Jerry and Janet were comparing the distance they ran over a week. If Jerry ran 20.33 miles and Janet ran 8.7 miles, how far did they run total?
- 3) A computer programmer had two files with a total size of 84.53 gigabytes. If one of the files was 36.83 gigabytes, how big is the second file?
- 4) A weatherman was measuring the amount of rain two cities received over a week. City A received 8.42 inches while City B received 1.1 inches. How much rain did they get total?
- 5) Edward weighed the candy he and his brother got from Halloween. Together they received 14.75 kg of candy. If Edward's amount was 10.45 kg how much was his brothers?
- 6) Sam was training for a marathon. On his first day he ran 2.46 kilometers. On the second day he ran 3.7 kilometers. How far did he run altogether?
- 7) Henry was checking how much power his lights used. His first light by itself used 57.87 amps. When he turned on the second light, together they used 129.47 amps. How many amps did just the second light use?
- 8) Haley was measuring how much taller she got over two years. In the first year she grew 4.27 cm. In the second year she grew 8.4 cm. How much taller did she get altogether?
- 9) Luke bought 5.43 lbs of cherry and lime jelly beans for his birthday party. If 3.23 lbs were cherry flavor, how many pounds were lime flavor?
- 10) Olivia was trying to put some files on her flash drive. If she had one file that was 7.31 mb and another file that was 8.3 mb what is their combined file size?
