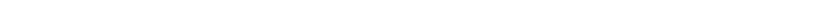




**Use the numberline to solve each problem.**

## Answers

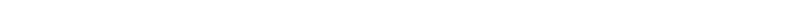
1)  $30 \div 10 = 0$



2)  $28 \div 7 = 0$

3)  $6 \div 3 = 0$

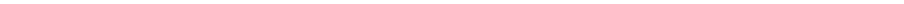

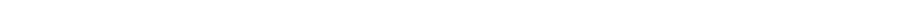
4)  $32 \div 8 = 0$

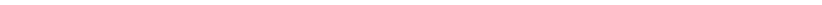

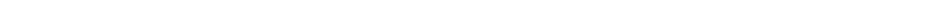

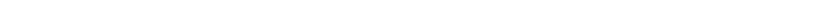

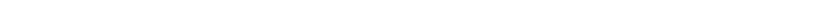
9)  $36 \div 9 = 0$
