



Use the visual model to solve each problem.

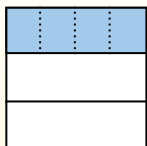
Answers

$\frac{1}{3} \div 4 = ?$

Split the whole into 3 pieces and fill in 1 section.

Next split $\frac{1}{3}$ into 4 groups.

To figure out the size of each piece in comparison to the whole, split the whole into 4 groups.



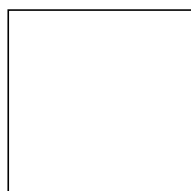
To solve, start with a whole.

Now you can see the size of $\frac{1}{3}$

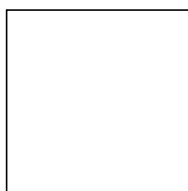
This shows the size of each piece.

Each piece is $\frac{1}{12}$ of the whole. Or: $\frac{1}{3} \div 4 = \frac{1}{12}$

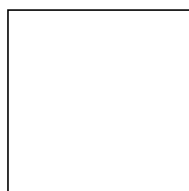

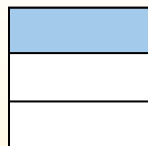
Use the visual model to solve each problem.

$$\frac{1}{3} \div 4 = ?$$



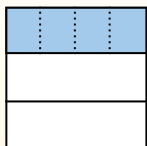
To solve, start with a whole.

Split the whole into 3 pieces and fill in 1 section.



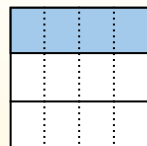
Now you can see the size of $\frac{1}{3}$

Next split $\frac{1}{3}$ into 4 groups.



This shows the size of each piece.

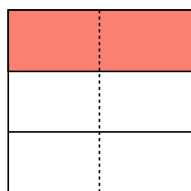
To figure out the size of each piece in comparison to the whole, split the whole into 4 groups.



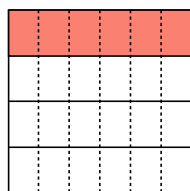
Each piece is $\frac{1}{12}$ of the whole. Or: $\frac{1}{3} \div 4 = \frac{1}{12}$
