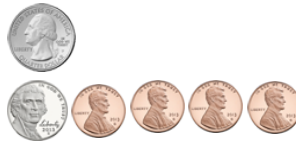
- 3) At the fair Janet spent \$17.24 buying fair food. She gave the cashier the money shown. How much change should she get back?

- 6) Edward bought \$12.97 worth of groceries. He gave the cashier the money shown. How much change should he get back?





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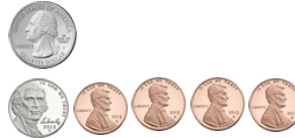
